She focused on clients in higher education and in the public sector while also serving clients in the real estate and insurance sectors. She also served as Deloitte's national compliance partner for public sector. She is an expert in compliance and government accounting practices and procedures, serving two terms on the federal Advisory Council of Government Auditing Standards.

A recognized financial and operational leader on campus, Kris lends her expertise on committees including the Fraud Assessment Crime Team, the Internal Bank Committee, Athletic Council's Finance and Facilities committee, Senate Fiscal, University Risk Management, Integrated Capital Planning Committee and The University Reaccreditation Committee.
