- Managed by Office of International Affairs and Enterprise Risk Management

- Zurich
 - Supplemental insurance for Ohio State faculty, staff and students traveling abroad for business
 - Coverage for medical and security incidents
 - No enrollment or registration requirement for faculty and staff
 - Students must register their travel
- Crisis24

Crisis24 Assistance Services Snapshot

- Comprehensive emergency traveler assistance
- 24/7 medical and security advice before, during, and after travel
- Destination health guidance and preparedness planning
- Access to qualified medical and mental health providers
- Assistance coordinating appointments and medical care abroad
- Emergency medical evacuation and repatriation services

International Travel Safety Updates

- Ohio State supports global travel advancing academic, research and business objectives
- Travel is generally permitted and is managed through a risk-informed approach
- Travel may be restricted where insurance coverage or emergency assistance are unavailable or severely limited
- Travel to the Middle East region is currently suspended due to ongoing risk
- Note that more restrictive travel policies and approval requirements apply to students
