He is responsible for enterprise banking and merchant services, cash and liquidity management, operating funds investment, planning for and funding university capital needs, debt capital markets functions, rating agency and investor relations, parking concession agreement oversight, tuition and fees billing and collection, and centralized accounts receivable along with other university financial initiatives.



Jake serves as the Treasurer of Campus Partners, Assistant Treasurer of the Ohio State Foundation, a board member of the Hospital Self-Insurance Board, and a member of the Retirement Oversight Committee and Senior Management Council.

Jake has 20 years of experience spanning the capital markets, government, and higher education. Prior to joining Ohio State in 2017, Jake was a Director for KeyBanc Capital Markets. Jake previously spent nine years as Director of Debt Management for the Ohio Treasurer of State's office. There he facilitated the issuance of approximately \$13 billion of municipal debt obligations including the nation's largest tax-exempt tobacco securitization (\$5.4 billion).
